The Show Schedule: Show starts at 10:00 am

1. Fitting and Showing—starting with Pee-Wee
2. Grand Championship for Fitting and Showing
Only the Champion Exhibitors/Cats from each division may enter this class

Entry Fees: Due April 15th—\$7.00 for both days for 1 cat/\$4.00 for 2nd cat. After April 15th—\$8.00 for 1 cat/\$5.00 for 2nd cat

RULES:

1. You may show up to two cats. Please let superintendent know if going in separate cages. Only one cat can be entered in Fitting and Showing.
2. Please use a cat carrier to transport to the show.
3. No pregnant or nursing cats allowed.
4. Cats must be a minimum of four (4) months of age to show.
5. Kittens are 4 months to 12 months of age. Senior cats are over 10 years of age.
6. All cats **MUST** have nails clipped (1/8 inch from the quick is recommended). You may show declawed cats.
7. All cats **MUST** have proof of current vaccinations for all **feline** respiratory diseases and **rabies**.
8. **ALL CATS MUST BE ON HARNESS AND LEASH AT ALL TIMES.** We recommend an "H" style harness.
9. Full cages (size 21" W x 21" H x 45" L) will be provided but recommend to bring your own if able.
10. It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to care for their own cats or to see that someone is on duty at all times that cats are on display. **This rule will be strictly enforced for the safety of the cat.**
11. All cats are entered at the owner's risk. The show committee, the Spring Youth Fair staff or S.W.W. Fair staff will not be held responsible for injury or loss of exhibits or exhibitors.
12. Class times will be posted each morning, but times are subject to change. Please watch for schedule changes.
13. Anyone under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult (parent, 4-H Leader, etc...)
14. Mail entry form with money order or check made payable to "SPRING YOUTH FAIR".
15. **BRING TO THE FAIR:** Proof of vaccination for ALL respiratory diseases and rabies. Also bring food and water dishes, litter and litter box, harness & leash, cat crate, cat food/treats for food drive. Bring curtains/sheets to cover cage and table.

****Novice - 1st year handlers who have never won a blue ribbon**

Ribbons: The ribbons will be judged and awarded on the Danish System. Fitting and Showing pattern will be judged on the 4-H pattern. Non 4-H will be given a fair chance to learn the Fitting and Showing pattern. The classes will be divided by 4-H system and by grades with an addition to the peewee class

PeeWee:	Preschool ages 3-5 must be accompanied by an adult or Advanced Senior and cat sharing is encouraged
Primary:	Kindergarten to 2nd grade
Junior:	3rd, 4th, and 5th grade
Intermediate:	6th, 7th, and 8th grade
Senior:	9th grade and above

It is recommended that EVERYONE make either a poster or some kind of educational display.

Let's fill our cat barn with lots of information about cats.
