Classes I, II, III

Individual prints are to be no larger than 8 ½" X 11" and should be suitably mounted for display on sturdy background stock or matter board.

*Story-telling picture series to be mounted on one mount board no larger than 16" X 20".

Class IV- Posters to be no larger than 22" X 28". Factual

Class V- Length of video to be between 30 seconds and 2 minutes

Entry Fee will be \$1.00 per entry

Rules:

1. Every exhibit will receive a wristband which can be used as entry into the fair.
2. Entries are limited to eight (8) photos per exhibitor and one (1) video.
3. **PHOTOS-** Please use "PHOTO TAGS" to list NAME, AGE, PHONE NUMBER on the back of each photo or poster entry prior to bringing it to the fair.
4. **VIDEOS-** Title your film with your NAME, ADDRESS, AGE & PHONE NUMBER. Be sure to add your name to the video credits. Videos should be brought in on a thumb drive- we will upload to our computer and return to you.
5. **Classes I, II, & I II-** Photos will be judged by these criteria: Interest, Balance, Focus (except for special effects) and Mounting.
6. **Class IV-** Posters will be judged by these criteria: Factual information, flow of information, ease of understanding, thoroughness of subject. LOT 1 subject ideas: History of photography, famous photographer biography, photograph styles, dark room procedures, what makes a great photo, special effect processes, any other aspect of photography that interests you.
7. **Class V-** Videos will be judged by: Interest & Continuity. In addition each lot will be judged by the following:
 - a. Lot 1- For "Serious How-To": Effectiveness of instruction.
 - b. Lot 2- For "Parody How-To": Entertainment value
8. **1st, 2nd, or 3rd place ribbons** will be given for **each entry**.
9. **Champion Ribbons** will be awarded in **each Division for each class**.
10. **People's Choice Trophies**
 - a. One for "Crowd Favorite" in each photography Division (2 total)
 - b. One for "Crowd Favorite" video (1 total)
