Exhibits will be accepted for judging on the Tuesday, before fair from 4:00 - 8:00 pm. Others who simply wish to display their exhibit may enter them until 5:00 pm on Friday, May 5th. If entered after Tuesday they will not be judged, if you have any questions please call.

NOTE: THE ENTRY DATE IS ON TUESDAY ONLY!!!

1. One entry form per person.

2. NO MORE THAN FOUR ENTRIES PER PERSON. Two or more like items will be a single item.

3. All exhibits should be labeled with name, address and phone number prior to entering.

4. Placement ribbons will be presented to all participants. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Rosette ribbons will be given at the discretion of the Judges.

5. Operational Units in Class A can be completed or work in progress and will be judged on the progress that has been done.

6. Department will be closed Sunday from 4:00 - 5:00 pm.

7. **EXHIBITS MUST BE CLAIMED BETWEEN 5:00 - 6:00 pm SUNDAY OF FAIR.** No storage available for projects not picked up on Sunday. Contact Spring Youth Fair office to arrange alternate pickup if available.

8. Please keep in mind that as the department grows, space becomes limited. While we strive to accommodate everyone, display cases may not always be available. While sharing display case space may seem to be a distraction, it will in no way affect judging.
